

Serratia is a genus of Gram-negative bacteria belonging to the family Enterobacteriaceae. These bacteria are known for their ability to produce a characteristic red pigment called prodigiosin, especially under certain environmental conditions. *Serratia* species are found in various environments, including water, soil, plants, and the gastrointestinal tracts of animals.
