Abnormally elevated serum AFP may occur in [ovarian cancer](#), stomach cancer, lung cancer, colon cancer, pancreas cancer, as well as in [cirrhosis](#) or [hepatitis](#) and in the majority of gravid women carrying a fetus with an [open neural tube defect](#);

Serum AFP>500ng/ml usually means primary [liver tumor](#).

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
