

Spinal nerve root



A spinal [nerve root](#), the beginning of one of the thirty-one pairs leaving the central nervous system from the [spinal cord](#). Each [spinal nerve](#) root consists of the union of a sensory dorsal root and a motor ventral root.

Lumbar foraminal stenosis (LFS) is defined as when the [spinal nerve roots](#) are compressed on the side due to narrowing of the foramen that may be caused by a foraminal herniated disc, a collapsed disc space, or an enlarged joint.
