Myoclonus is the muscle jerking that occurs involuntarily, like a [spasm](#) or shaking sensation. When the stapedius muscle, which is attached to the stapes, begins to have a spasm it creates vibrations and sounds. ... Caused by exposure to loud sounds, stress, and facial nerve spasms.
