

Stimulation-induced seizures

Stimulation-induced [seizures](#) (SISs) are rare but serious events during [electrocortical stimulation](#) (ECS) [mapping](#). SISs are most common when [mapping](#) the [frontal lobe](#). Greater [stimulation current](#) is not associated with the identification of more cortical functional sites during [glioma surgery](#)¹⁾.
