

Struther's ligament

Distinct from [struthers arcade](#) which is a normal finding. The [supracondylar process \(SCP\)](#) is an anatomical variant located 5–7 cm above medial [epicondyle](#), present in 0.7–2.7% of population.

Struther's ligament bridges the SCP to the medial [epicondyle](#). The [median nerve](#) and [brachial artery](#) pass underneath, the [ulnar nerve](#) may also. Usually asymptomatic, but occasionally may cause typical median nerve syndrome.
