

Cerebrospinal fluid analysis to exclude infections such as tertiary [syphilis](#) or [subacute sclerosing panencephalitis](#) is recommended. Toxicity from [bismuth](#), [bromides](#), and [lithium](#) must be ruled-out. [Myoclonus](#) is usually more prominent early in toxic/metabolic disorders than in [Creutzfeldt-Jakob disease](#), and [seizures](#) in CJD are usually late <sup>1)</sup>
