

# Superficial temporal vein

A case of a progressive left [internal carotid artery](#) (ICA) communicating segment [atherosclerosis](#) in a 34-year-old woman. An [indirect bypass](#) using the superficial temporal vein (STV) was decided based on the absence of the left parietal branch of the STA <sup>1)</sup>.
