


# Superior colliculus



The optic tectum or simply **tectum** is a paired structure that forms a major component of the vertebrate **midbrain**. In mammals, this structure is more commonly called the superior colliculus (Latin, upper hill), but, even in mammals, the adjective tectal is commonly used.
