



Superior fovea

A slight depression in the limiting sulcus (sulcus limitans [TA]) on either side of the rhomboid fossa, above the medullary striae and lateral to the facial colliculus.

Synonym(s): fovea superior [TA], anterior fovea, fovea anterior.



Floor of the fourth ventricle: fc: **facial colliculus**; ht: **hypoglossal triangle**; if: **inferior fovea**; me: **medial eminence**; ms: **median sulcus**; o: **obex**; sf: **superior fovea**; sl: **sulcus limitans**; sm: **medullary striae of fourth ventricle**; vt: **vagal triangle**.



Ap: **area postrema**; icp: **inferior cerebellar peduncle**; lr: **lateral recess**; ms: **median sulcus**; scp: **superior cerebellar peduncle**; sf: **superior fovea**; sm: **Medullary striae of fourth ventricle**.
