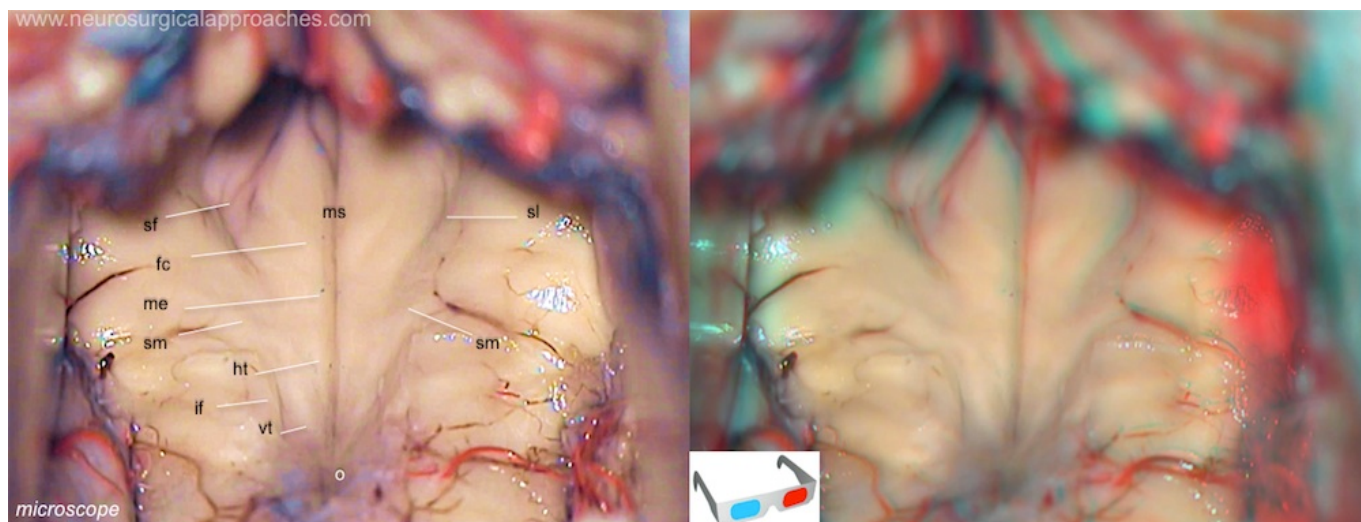


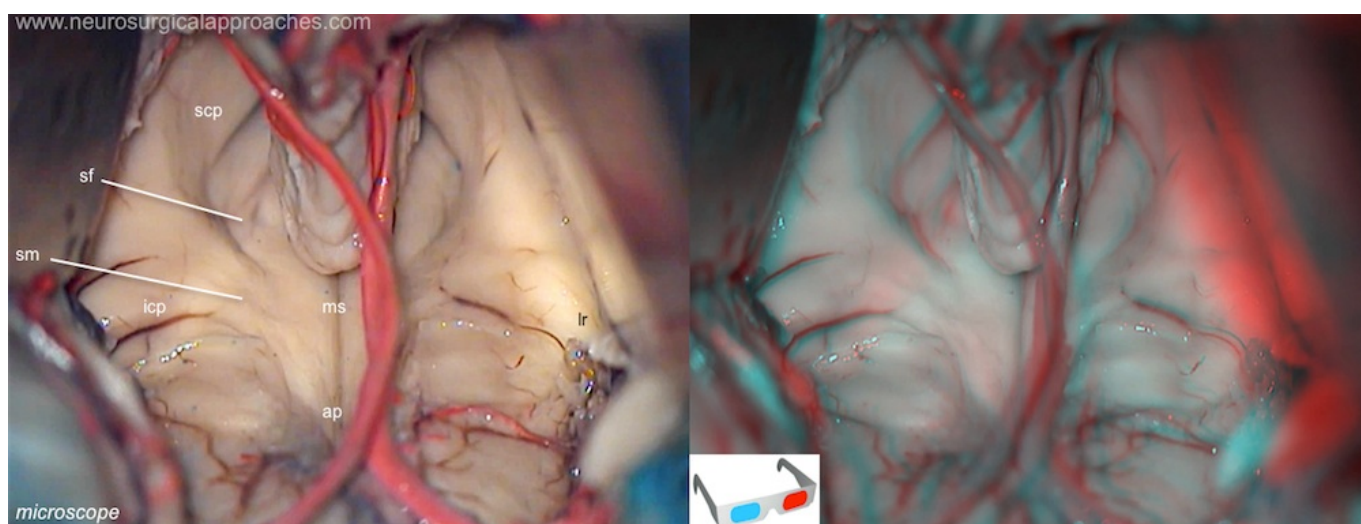
Superior fovea

A slight depression in the limiting sulcus (sulcus limitans [TA]) on either side of the **rhomboid fossa**, above the medullary striae and lateral to the facial colliculus.

Synonym(s): fovea superior [TA], anterior fovea, fovea anterior.
