


Massive ventricular dilatation causes stretching and dehiscence of the **fornix** with formation of unilateral or bilateral pial pulsion diverticula of the inferior medial wall of the **atrium**. Enlargement of the pial pouch creates a dramatic **subarachnoid cyst** that may herniate downward through the incisura into the lateral mesencephalic, precentral cerebellar, and **superior vermian cisterns** where it displaces the brain stem, vermis, and fourth ventricle.



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
