

Suprasellar aneurysm

Suprasellar [aneurysm](#) producing endocrine disturbance due to [pituitary gland](#) ¹⁾ or [stalk](#) compression.

[Superior hypophyseal artery aneurysms](#):

a) paraclinoid variant: usually does not produce visual symptoms

b) suprasellar variant: when giant, may mimic [pituitary tumor](#) on CT. Suprasellar variant may actually grow to a size large enough to compress the pituitary stalk and cause [hypopituitarism](#) and “classic” chiasmal visual symptoms ([Bitemporal hemianopsia](#)).
