Conventional [surfactant proteins](#) (A, B, C, and D) are important players of the innate [immunity](#) in the [central nervous system](#) and serve as effective regulators of [cerebrospinal fluid](#) rheology, probably being involved in clearance of detrimental [metabolites](#) like [beta-amyloid](#) and phospho-[tau](#).
