

Tectal ganglioglioma

Tumours of the [quadrigeminal plate in adults](#) are usually [benign](#). Nevertheless, [obstructive hydrocephalus](#) due to compression of the [Sylvian aqueduct](#) is an almost invariable early finding. Whether or not direct excision is undertaken, temporary or permanent treatment of the [hydrocephalus](#) is warranted. [Endoscopic third ventriculostomy](#) is an alternative to insertion of a [shunt](#) and provides both acute and long-term relief of hydrocephalus-related symptoms.

Cultrera et al., chose a two-stage approach for treating a tectal ganglioglioma in an adult: endoscopic third ventriculostomy followed by surgical excision ¹⁾.
