Tortuous

Definition: In medical terminology, "tortuous" describes an anatomical structure—typically a vessel, duct, or pathway—that is **excessively twisted, winding, or meandering**.

Clinical relevance: Tortuous anatomy can **impede catheter navigation**, increase procedural complexity, and may be associated with underlying vascular pathology (e.g., atherosclerosis, elongation, or stenosis).

Examples:

- Tortuous internal carotid artery
- Tortuous sigmoid sinus
- Tortuous ureter
