Case series

A transcavernous approach was used in 91 cases (50 complex upper [basilar artery aneurysms](#), 30 upper [petroclival meningiomas](#) of the junction, five [trigeminal schwannomas](#), three upper [clival chordomas](#), and three anterior pontine lesions) involving the anterior upper third of the posterior fossa ¹⁾.
