

The transverse occipital sulcus is a structure in the [occipital lobe](#).

The transverse occipital sulcus is continuous with the posterior end of the occipital ramus of the [intraparietal sulcus](#), and runs across the upper part of the lobe, a short distance behind the [parietooccipital sulcus](#).
