Traumatic [brain injury](#) (TBI) is defined as a result of a [bump](#), [blow](#) or [jolt](#) to the [head](#) or a [penetrating head injury](#) that disrupts the normal function of the [brain](#). This [trauma](#) can lead to temporary or permanent [impairments](#) of cognitive, physical, and psychosocial functions, and an associated diminished or altered state of [consciousness](#)¹⁾.

Although there are still contradictions regarding the clinical significance of the term “[head injury](#)”, it can not be considered synonymous with [traumatic brain injury](#).
