

Tremor-predominant Parkinson's disease

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[Tremor](#)-predominant [Parkinson's disease](#) is characterised by prominent tremor of one or more [limbs](#) with a relative lack of significant [rigidity](#) and [bradykinesia](#). Despite the lack of other disabling motor symptoms, the tremor of tremor-predominant Parkinson's disease can be very disabling, especially if a postural and kinetic component exists.
