

Uncinate process

The uncinate process is a structure found in the anatomy of the human body, specifically in the head and neck region. It refers to a small, hook-shaped projection or process that extends from the lateral and inferior aspect of the vertebral body of the cervical spine, particularly in the upper cervical vertebrae (C3-C6).
