

Uremic neuropathy

This occurs in [chronic renal failure](#). Early symptoms include calf cramps (“Charlie horses”), dysesthesia in feet (similar to painful [diabetic neuropathy](#)) and “restless legs.” [Achilles reflexes](#) are lost. A stocking sensory loss is followed later by LE [weakness](#) that starts distally and ascends. The offending [toxin](#) is not known. [Dialysis](#) or renal transplantation relieves the symptoms.
