



The elevation between the **median sulcus** and **sulcus limitans** (i.e. the region for motor neurons), is known as the **medial eminence**, while the lateral region (i.e. that for the sensory neurons) is known as the **vestibular area**. The **sulcus limitans** bifurcates at either end - the **superior fovea** cerebrally, and the **inferior fovea** caudally.
