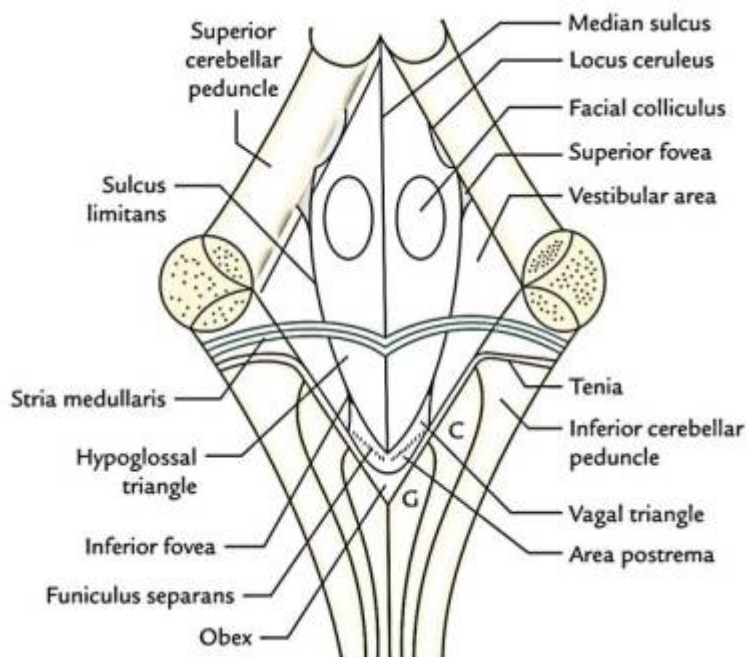




The elevation between the [median sulcus](#) and [sulcus limitans](#) (i.e. the region for motor neurons), is known as the [medial eminence](#), while the lateral region (i.e. that for the sensory neurons) is known as the [vestibular area](#). The [sulcus limitans](#) bifurcates at either end - the [superior fovea](#) cerebrally, and the [inferior fovea](#) caudally.

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
