

The [vidian canal](#) (VC), a bony tunnel in which the [vidian artery](#) and [vidian nerve](#) pass, has been widely known as an important landmark to identify the anterior genu of the petrous carotid artery (AGPCA) especially during lateral extended endoscopic endonasal approaches (LEEEAs).
