

The zygomaticomaxillary complex (ZMC) refers to the anatomical region of the face that involves the articulation between the [zygoma](#) (cheekbone) and the [maxilla](#) (upper jaw). This complex is a critical component of the midface and contributes to the structural support of the [orbit](#) (eye socket).

The ZMC includes the [zygomatic arch](#), the zygomaticofrontal suture, and the zygomaticomaxillary suture.
