

The zygomaticomaxillary complex (ZMC) refers to the anatomical region of the face that involves the articulation between the **zygoma** (cheekbone) and the **maxilla** (upper jaw). This complex is a critical component of the midface and contributes to the structural support of the **orbit** (eye socket).

The ZMC includes the **zygomatic arch**, the zygomaticofrontal suture, and the zygomaticomaxillary suture.
