

The zygomaticotemporal nerve or zygomaticotemporal branch (temporal branch) is a small nerve in the face. It is derived from the [maxillary nerve](#).

It runs along the [orbital lateral wall](#) in a groove in the [zygomatic bone](#), receives a branch of communication from the [lacrimal nerve](#), and passes through the [zygomaticotemporal foramen](#) in the zygomatic bone to enter the [temporal fossa](#).
